		 Cuts complex shapes with good accuracy within ¼ inch of the cutting

		 Copies most easy shapes (cross, circle, square, triangle). 		
		 Prints all numerals 0 to 9 and all upper and lower case letters without copying 		
		 Prints simple words on the baseline with acceptable letter sizing, spacing, and orientation.
